Cardiovascular Pharmacy Fellow

Primary Goal

Educate a scientific clinician—capable of independent clinical research, advancement of cardiovascular pharmacotherapy, and statewide/regional practice implementation.

Tracks and Durations

- PGY-1 graduate (or equivalent experiences) track: 2 years
- PGY-2 graduate (or equivalent experiences) track: 1 year (accelerated)
